**PEOPLE'S UNITED COMMUNITY FOUNDATION AWARDS
OVER \$700,000 IN GRANTS TO NORTHEASTERN NONPROFITS**

BRIDGEPORT, CT – The People's United Community Foundation, the philanthropic arm of People's United Bank (NASDAQ: PBCT), announced today that it awarded \$721,500 in grants to nonprofit organizations throughout the communities it serves in Connecticut, New York, Massachusetts, Vermont, New Hampshire and Maine.

One hundred eleven organizations received funding in support of activities that ranged from education programs and basic needs services to workforce development programs and affordable housing. The funding was distributed within the foundation's three areas of focus, with 50 percent allocated to youth development, 31 percent to community development, and 19 percent to affordable housing initiatives.

Recipients included Achievement First and Bridgeport Rescue Mission in Connecticut, Long Island Housing Partnership and Boys and Girls Club Northern Westchester in New York, Franklin County Community and Lawrence Community Works in Massachusetts, Vermont Community Loan Fund and College of Saint Joseph in Vermont, Big Brothers Big Sisters of Western New Hampshire and Housing Partnership in New Hampshire, and Gulf of Maine Research Institute and Goodwill Industries of Northern New England in Maine.

"Many outstanding nonprofit organizations in our communities are doing exceptional work to meet the needs of residents," said Vincent Santilli, Executive Director of the foundation. "People's United Community Foundation is pleased to support a significant number of these agencies throughout our footprint that are consistently demonstrating positive results."
